## PROPOSED SECOND NOTICE FOR AMENDMENTS TO NOISE REGULATIONS ISSUED FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

On April 3, 2003, the Illinois Pollution Control Board adopted a proposed second notice for public comment in the rulemaking entitled <u>Noise Rule Update: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 900 and 903</u>, R03-08. The proposed second notice is intended to give the public time to review and comment on the changes made since the Board's first notice opinion and order was adopted on December 19, 2002.

The Board initiated this rulemaking to amend and update the Board's noise rules. The rulemaking proposal would update definitions and sound measurement procedures contained in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 900. These definitions and measurement procedures were adopted in 1973. One basis for these changes is the American National Standards Institute updates that occurred from 1998-2001. The Board has also proposed the repeal of Part 903 as legislative changes have exempted organized sporting events including motor racing facilities from the Board's noise regulations.

The public has 45 days to make comments on this proposal before the Board adopts the proposal for second notice. Written public comments should contain the docket number, R03-08, and may be sent to the address listed below.

The Board held two hearings on the proposal.
