
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. McFawn):

Section 22.4(d) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/22.4(d) (1996)) requires the Board to adopt regulations which are identical-in-substance to underground storage tank (UST) regulations promulgated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) pursuant to Section 9003 of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act to implement Subtitle I of RCRA, with certain limitations. 42 U.S.C. §6991(b) (1976). USEPA has codified its UST regulations at 40 CFR 281 through 283. The Board reserved this docket for any UST amendments adopted by USEPA between January 1, 1997 and June 30, 1997. However, USEPA did not amend its UST regulations during this period.

For the foregoing reasons, the Board hereby dismisses this proceeding and closes this docket.
