

Board Sends Noise Rulemaking To First Notice

The Illinois Pollution Control Board, on March 17, 2005, sent to a second first notice the noise rulemaking entitled Proposed New And Updated Rules For Measurement and Numerical Sound Emissions Standards Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 901 and 910, (R03-9).

The proposal would create new and update existing regulations governing noise to reflect present scientific standards for many of the sound measurement definitions and techniques contained in the Board's rules. Further, this rulemaking would revise outdated numerical sound emission standards for property line noise sources found at 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 901, and add a new Part 910 to the Board's regulations. The new Part incorporates noise measurement techniques currently contained only in Illinois Environmental Protection Agency rules at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 951.

This rulemaking is closely associated with the rules adopted in September 2003 in Noise Rule Update Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 900 and 903, (R03-8) that define acoustical terms, pollution sources and sound measurement procedures. The rules adopted in R03-8 are based on updated science, including pertinent American National Standards Institute updates from 1998-2001, and other current scientific publications.

The Board held four public hearings on this proposed rulemaking. Opinions and orders of the Board, hearing transcripts, and other documents in this rulemaking record are posted on the Board's Web site and may be downloaded from the Web without charge.
