AAD Family Farms, LLC</u> – In response to a joint stipulation and proposed settlement agreement in this administrative citation action involving a Woodford County facility, the Board found that respondent had violated Section 21(p)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2012)) and ordered respondent to pay a civil penalty of \$1,500. The Board also granted the parties' joint motion to dismiss respondent's petition for review. To effectuate the parties' intent that respondent pay a total civil penalty of \$1,500, the Board on its own motion dismissed the alleged violations of Section $21(p)(3)$ and $(p)(7)$ of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS $5/21(p)(3), 21(p)(7)$ (2012)).	4-0
