Illinois Pollution Control Board Grants 45-day Provisional Variance to Berlin Industries, Inc.

Chicago - The Illinois Pollution Control Board granted a 45-day provisional variance from air pollution standards to Berlin Industries, Inc. The provisional variance is for activities at the commercial lithographic plant located in Carol Stream, DuPage County. It will allow Berlin to operate its printing lines while a damper in its existing thermal afterburner is replaced with a state-of-art, three armed design.

This action, docketed as PCB 02-43, was taken by the Board upon notification by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency that compliance with air pollution standards, would impose an arbitrary or unreasonable hardship on the Berlin Industries, Inc.
