Board Adopts First-Notice Amendments to Non-Hazardous Solid Waste Rules

On July 12, 2007, the Illinois Pollution Control Board adopted for first-notice a proposal to amend Parts 810 and 811 of the Board's regulations governing solid waste disposal and standards for new solid waste landfills. The Illinois Chapter of the National Solid Wastes Management Association (NSWMA) filed the proposal (<u>Proposed Amendments to Solid Waste Landfill Rules, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 810 and 811</u> (R07-08) with the Board on July 27, 2006.

The first-notice amendments are intended primarily to update the Board's regulations in order to reflect practical experience gained through the implementation of those rules and the expanded technical and scientific knowledge achieved since the Board first adopted these standards in 1990.

Publication of these proposed amendments in the *Illinois Register* will begin a 45-day public comment period.
