

Board Adopted Changes to Procedural Rules

On January 24, 2013, the Pollution Control Board adopted a single amendment to the Board's existing procedural rule codified at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.108(d) "Board Proceedings." The rulemaking is docketed as In the Matter of: Proposed Amendment to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.108 9(d) Conforming to P.A. 93-509 Re Board Majority (R13-9).

The amendment clarifies that the affirmative votes of a three Member majority of this five Member Board is required to adopt a Board decision.
