ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):

On February 9, 1977, the Illinois Manufacturers' Association (IMA) filed a proposed amendment to Rule 204 of the Board's Air Pollution Regulations which limits SO₂ emissions. The Board currently has before it several proceedings, including R 71-23, R 74-2, R 75-5, and R 76-9, which concern the sulfur dioxide emission limitations.

The Board finds that yet another regulatory proposal would only serve to accentuate the existing uncertainty as to the status of the SO₂ regulations. Therefore, the Board rejects IMA's February 9 petition as duplicitous of matters currently before the Board.
