#### JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

#### **FACTS**

- 1. That Flossie E. Hayes is the current owner and Kevin E. Stine is the current owner ("collectively Respondents") of a facility located at 109 Broadway Street, Iola, Clay County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Iola/Hayes-Stine.
  - That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 0250150004.
  - That Respondents have owned or operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on July 17, 2013, Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 8-27-13, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7011 1150 0001 0862 2995 - Hayes.

#### **VIOLATIONS**

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of his July 17, 2013 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).

#### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>September 30, 2013</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

# PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.



Subject: Open Dump Site Inspection at Hayes-Stine Site

General Remarks: An Open Dump Site Inspection was conducted on Wednesday, July 17, 2013 at property owned by Flossie Hayes. The inspection was conducted by Garrison Gross representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land. The property address is ~109 Broadway Street in Iola, Illinois. The inspection was a follow-up to a previous inspection conducted August 30, 2012. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were clear skies, 86° F, with a light breeze. Surface conditions were dry.

Inspection Findings: The inspection began at approximately 8:50 A.M. The property was overgrown in tall grass (photo 001). I entered the property and continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site. A pit measuring approximately 50 feet long by 30 feet wide by 3 feet deep was observed. The pit contained partially burned demolition debris including but not limited to: bricks, concrete blocks, wood, metal, tile siding and ash (photos 002 and 004). Exterior tile siding was observed that appeared to be transite, a suspected asbestos containing material (photo 003). The pile contained approximately 150 cubic yards of material. The inspection ended at approximately 8:55 A.M.

Additional Remarks: Information concerning property ownership / control was obtained through tax records available from the Supervisor of Assessment's Office in Clay County. Tax bills are mailed to Flossie Hayes, 505 Peacock Drive, Farina, Illinois 62838. The property is referred to as parcel # 01-34-401-005-0060 (Lots # 5 and 6, Block 3, Village of Iola).




