### JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

#### **FACTS**

- That Union National Bank Land Trust 1516 is the current owner ("Respondent") of a facility located at 1600 Pleasant Street, DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as DeKalb/Union National Bank Land Trust 1516.
  - That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 0370105255.
  - That Respondent has owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on August 7, 2013, Donna Shehane of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Rockford Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 9-10-13, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7011 1150 0001 0863 8842

### **VIOLATIONS**

Based upon direct observations made by Donna Shehane during the course of her August 7, 2013 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondent caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2010).

### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>October 21, 2013</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each

violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

# PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

#### NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT DOCUMENT

On August 7, 2013 I (Donna Shehane) conducted a follow-up inspection at 1600 Pleasant Street, DeKalb, IL 60115. According to County Records, this property is owned by Union National Bank Land Trust 1516 @ 101 E Chicago Street, Elgin, IL 60123. The weather at the time of this inspection was 82 F with west winds @ 8 mph and scattered clouds. The previous inspection of this site occurred on April 10, 2013 which resulted in a Used Tire Administrative Citation Warning Notice. The purpose of this inspection was to verify compliance with the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act and 35 Illinois Administrative Code regulations Part 848: Used Tire Regulations.

I arrived on site at approximately 11:05 am. A deadline of May 20, 2013 had been given to drain all water accumulation out of the tires and removed them to a tire disposal/recycling facility. On June 24, 2013 I received an e-mail from Jade Peterson stating that they had begun removing 10 tires at a time and also included a receipt dated June 21, 2013 from Blain's Farm & Fleet in Sycamore, IL.

I inventoried approximately 60 used or waste tires remaining on site at the time of this inspection (See photos # 1 and # 4). Several of the off-rim used tires contained water accumulation (See photos # 2, # 3, # 5, # 6, and # 7).


The Union National Bank Land Trust 1516 site was found to remain out of compliance at the time of this inspection. Apparent violations noted:

- 1. Section 55(a)(3) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act ("Act").
- 2. Section 55(k)(1) of the Act.




