previous landowners and like i said we were cleaning up that area to improve the property,, therefor we ask that this case be dismissed


since we did not personally cause or allow these issues to occur and were not a direct result of our doings and were not in control of what


was left behind, as well there are no photos of any person dumping or doing anything illegal of Mr Wagner's findings, all those photos show
