JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014).

FACTS

- 1. That George W. Woodcock, Jr. is the current owner and George W. Woodcock III d/b/a West Drilling Company is the current operator ("Respondents") of a facility located at 15716 Highway 1, approximately one mile north of Mt. Carmel, Wabash County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Mt. Carmel/West Drilling Company.
 - 2. That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 1850205044.
 - 3. That Respondents have owned/operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on December 30, 2015, Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of

his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on <u>2-10-16</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>7012 0470 0001 3000 7060 G. Woodcock III</u> 7012 0470 0001 3000 7077 G. Woodcock III.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of his December 30, 2015 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2014).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2014), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>March 15, 2016</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental

Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2014), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in

accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2014). If Respondents elect to contest

this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a

Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois

Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois

60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection

Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield,

Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within

thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution

Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

General Remarks: A follow-up Open Dump Site Inspection was conducted on Wednesday, December 30, 2015 at West Drilling Company. The business is located at 15716 Highway 1, approximately 1 mile north of Mt. Carmel, Illinois. The site consists of an irregular shaped parcel. The inspection was performed as a follow-up to a previous inspection conducted on October 19, 2015. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were overcast skies, 35° F, with a moderate breeze. Surface conditions were dry. The inspection began at approximately 12:55 P.M and ended at 1:00 P.M. Two (2) photographs were taken. Apparent violations were found which are discussed below.

<u>Inspection Findings</u>: The site was observed from Illinois State Route 1 and it appeared that additional waste items had been dumped in the earthen pit. I entered the site and drove to the small hill that surrounded the earthen pit. Based on the previous site conditions, it was evident that additional waste items had been dumped in the earthen pit. I continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site.

<u>Open Dumping</u>: The earthen bermed pit contained additional waste items not observed during the previous inspection. New wastes included but were not limited to: rubber hose, furniture drawers, cardboard, insulation, and trash (photos 001 and 002). It did not appear that any waste had been removed from the site.

Additional Comments: According to information obtained from the Supervisor of Assessment's Office in Wabash County, tax bills are mailed to George Woodcock, Jr., 422 N. Cherry Street, Mt. Carmel, Illinois 62863. The site contains one parcel, #05-111-08-200-014 which contains 4.95 acres.




