Subject: "single seat license" R16-17

Good morning, again. As discussed, in response to your request to come up with a definition of "single seat license," I suggested the alternative of eliminating the jargon "single seat license" and simply replacing it with a plain description of what the Board means. I suggest the revised language below, which would appear in Section 101.302(h)(4)(B):

File a single-seat license or similar documentation of access that, at no charge to the Board, gives the Board the rights, during and after the rulemaking, to do the following: electronically access the copyrighted document on only one computer at the Board's Chicago office; print a single copy of the copyrighted document to maintain at the Board's Chicago office; and print no more than a total of two copies of the copyrighted document if the Board is required by State law to furnish a copy to JCAR, a court, or a member of the public.

And, here are these changes in terms of the r02 document you sent for Part 101:

1. In line 1254, strike "single seat".
2. In line 1257, add "on only one computer at the Board's Chicago office" after "document".
