RESPONSE TO ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION AND EPA ENVIRONMENTAL PRO TECTION AGENCY COMPLAINTS

- 1. On July 15, 2010 Julie Webber made arrangements with the EPA to do an inspection of her property. Her son Jeff Webber had earlier in May 2010 filed a complaint with the EPA Peoria II. And Stark County Sheriff's office on violations on his mothers farm. Response came back that Julie Webber and Jeff Webber were not to be on the property. That the Camp Grove Bank had possession of the property and they were to stay off. Mr. Jeff Port responded that there was no violations. Upon this Jeff Webber called the EPA in Chicago, Illinois and filed a complaint. The agent at the EPA in Chicago made arrangements to inspect the property if Jeff Port did not do she would have an agent come down from Chicago to do it. They told him it would be done. Jeff Port called and met him on July 15, 2010.
- 2. The inspection found 22 violations that are not included in September 2010 inspection-which include damage to sewer lines, water lines, water way, water contamination, septic tank damage, and debris in water way. The dumping of grain, burning of farm chemicals, burning of tires to get to the rims, burning of vehicles. Paint and debris, chemicals and oil scattered across the ground. Dumping furniture and household goods from semi trailer and building and storage units. Trucks and farm equipment and parts scattered across the yard from equipments being sheared by 80000 lb. excavator. Leaving considerable damage to property from excessive weight. This accounts for so much debris incorporated in to the ground. Julie Webber requested a copy of this report and never received it. There fore give immediate attention to all the documentation, records and pictures by Jeff Port be made to Julie Webber and the Illinois EPA and the US EPA which is where the original complaint started in the investigation.

- 3. Michelle Ryan and Ms Webb several times in the telephone hearings since November 2010 have made accusations that Jeff Webber caused the debris and dumping on the property. Julie Webber informed them that Jeff Webber filed the complaint with the EPA and voiced what was going on at the property. The sheriff promptly arrested Jeff Webber for trespassing. This is the residence of Jeff Webber. Jeff and Julie Webber have tried to convey this to Ms. Ryan and Ms. Webb .Her response was I don't care. Julie Webber requests all records that Jeff Port did on May, June July of 2010 be made available to her. So that she can prepare a proper defense with an attorney who knows the law and is not personal friends with the banking corporations in the 10th judicial circuit. Which includes former Judge Brant, former judge Galley, former judge Brant, Judge McCuskey, judge Kouri and Judge Keith. Julie Webber feels the EPA has prolonged this issue to help the Camp Grove Bank, Larrys Scrap Metal, Rediger Auction Service and Hatzer Nordstrom Equipment Co. from being responsible for the damages to Webber property, personal and realstate.
- 4. Individuals responsible for damages and false information, falsified documents At the court house and falsified documents at the state of Illinois. UCCI commercial code filing. The law firm responsible Barash and Everett and attorney Keith Lymes . Any information to the Ill EPA from this law firm should be considered fraudulent. They have asked me for release so that I would not sue them. Which they did not receive.
- 5. Here are 3 cases from EPA records which show my view where the EPA goes after the land owner and the person responsible for damages and violations:

Prosecuted by: Megan Kistler and trail attorney Adam Cullman of Natural Resources Division of Justice Department -----Sunco Pipeline to pay for LP Crude spill on property at Barbers Hill, Texas 2009. And at Cromwell, Oklahoma 2011.

Burlington Northern vs. United States EPA . The owner is not responsible regardless of EPA rules. The party that comits the act is responsible. May 4, 2009

Chicago EPA . Scotts Lawn Service. Stop Sale, Use or removal order from individuals property. Home owner not penalized. The lawn Care service penalized. April 23, 2008

Final statement- Julie Webber a non attorney, has come to the conclusion that the EPA has not filled their obligations. Their attitude reminds me of the 3rd world countries where there are no Human rights for the elderly. I look to hear from you, hopefully some one who wants to clean up the environment.
