GENERAL REMARKS

Christy Vargochik representing the LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Land Use under the delegated authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency at the property of Wes and Jessica Whittaker performed a solid waste landfill inspection on October 3, 2013. The property is to the east of Dollar General and is described as parcel #03-20-120-000, Earl Township, Earlville, Illinois. During the inspection, the following violations were noted; causing or allowing open dumping; conducting any waste-storage, waste treatment, or waste disposal operation without a permit, disposing, treating or storing waste into the state not meeting requirements of Act; causing or allowing the open dumping of any waste that results in litter and scavenging; and failure to submit an application to develop and operate a landfill.

Weather conditions noted on arrival were rainy and approximately 75 degrees.

The inspection began at 11:50 a.m. I began the inspection from a private road that runs along the west side of the property to a trailer park. I photographed the area along Route 34, and some vehicles, a large truck and combine were parked in the area (photo 1301.24). I continued to the south, and found a truck, a tow truck, and other metal materials staged in the area to the west of the shed (photo 1301.25). I found more semi trailer trucks parked along the west edge partially obstructing the view to the site (photo 1301.26). I found more trailers, and dumpsters filled with material staged along the west edge of the site (photo n1301.27). I paused a moment to photograph a filled roll off and another trailer (photo 1301.28). At the south edge of the site, I photographed some vehicles that were obstructed by weeds (photo 1301.29). This concluded the inspection, and I left the site at 12:00 p.m.




