

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

This matter arises upon the Board's own initiative. On November 29, 1988, in response to a motion asserting that Petitioner was delinquent in filing briefs, this Board entered an order requiring the City of Farmington to file the required brief no later than December 9, 1988 or else this matter would be subject to dismissal. Board records show that a true and exact copy of that order was mailed on November 30, 1988 by certified mail.
