Hearing Officer Robertson,

As indicated in its rulemaking proposal, the Illinois EPA intends to submit portions of its proposed rule amendments in the above docket to USEPA for approval as State Implementation Plan revisions, if such amendments are adopted by the Board. Consequently, I'm writing to request that the following information be included in the Board's public hearing notice (specifically, the notice published in regional newspapers, or other publication method chosen by the Board):

If adopted by the Board, the Agency intends to submit the following to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for approval as State Implementation Plan (SIP) revisions: 1) The Agency's proposed changes to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 214 as revisions to Illinois' sulfur dioxide (SO₂) SIP, to satisfy Clean Air Act (CAA) requirements for areas designated nonattainment with respect to the 2010 SO₂ National Ambient Air Quality Standard; 2) The Agency's proposed changes to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 217.Subpart Q as revisions to Illinois' Nitrogen Oxides (NO_x) SIP Call Phase II SIP, to satisfy CAA requirements for NO_x and requirements set forth in USEPA's NO_x SIP Call Phase II Rule; and 3) The Agency's proposed changes to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 225.291, 225.292, 225.293, 225.295, 225.296 (except 225.296(d)), and 225.Appendix A as revisions to Illinois' Regional Haze SIP, to address visibility protection requirements set forth in the CAA.
