ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Parker):

It is the Order of the Pollution Control Board that the Petition in this case insofar as it relates to Phase I of the Green Bay Courts development, involving 300 living units, be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. Petitioner may not add a waste load of more than 910 population equivalents to the North Chicago plant of the North Shore Sanitary District; and
2. Petitioner may not cause or allow any discharge of any effluent to the North Chicago plant unless and until the North Chicago plant effluent, with the added waste load, meets the relevant standards of the Water Pollution Regulations of Illinois then in effect as certified by the Agency.

This Order is entered in view of the expiration today of the 90 day period of Section 38 of the Environmental Protection Act, as extended by waiver of Petitioner. The Board's opinion in support of this Order will follow.
