

This Amended Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 *et. Seq.*, specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

1. The Respondent, Union Pacific Railroad Company, is the present owner; and is in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Perry, State of Illinois. The Registered Agent of Union Pacific Railroad Company, is CT Corporation Systems.
2. The facility is an open dump and designated with the Site Code #1450155056. The facility is known to the Agency as the Pinckneyville/Union Pacific Railroad site.
3. The Respondent has owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
4. On May 15, 2013, Rebecca Tracy, Field Inspector, Perry County Solid Waste Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Ms. Tracy's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

VIOLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector, Rebecca Tracy's, direct observation, she has determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on May 15, 2013, an on-site inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

1. The Respondent has caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than August 1, 2013, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2006), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violations(s) as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and a finding of violation(s) as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- (1) Perry County Solid Waste, c/o Perry County Treasurer, Perry County Government Building, 3764 State Route 13/127, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274; and,

(2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, PO Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION


Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a Petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review shall also be filed with David Searby, Assistant State's Attorney, Perry County Courthouse, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274. **Your Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation. Your petition must state the reason(s) you believe the present matter should not be issued. If you fail to file your petition and state the reasons the present matter should not be issued, a default order against you will be entered by the Illinois Pollution Control Board.**




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Affiant, Rebecca Tracy, being first duly sworn, voluntarily deposes and states as follows:

Site: Intersection of railroad tracks and Fairground Road near the intersection of Highway 154

On May 15, 2013, an open dump inspection was performed at the intersection of Union Pacific Railroad property and Fairground Road in Pinckneyville, IL. The intersection is the one near the ball fields in the fairgrounds and Highway 154. The weather conditions were 85 degrees.

The information obtained from the Perry County Assessor's office indicates that the owner of the property is Union Pacific Railroad, 1400 Douglas Street, Omaha, NE 68179. According to the Illinois Secretary of State, the Registered Agent for Union Pacific Railroad Company is CT Corporation System, 208 South LaSalle Street, Suite 814, Chicago, IL 60604.

I arrived at the site at 1:42 p.m.

Photo 001 depicts open dumped railroad property in the form of spikes and buckets.

I left the site at 1:43 p.m.

DISCUSSION:

I contacted the number for illegal activity listed on the Union Pacific Railroad website several times regarding this matter. I was told by a representative of the company that the site would be cleaned up. However, the site was only partially cleaned up. The dump site is clearly visible from the road, is in a highly used recreational area and has the potential to cause problems in the form of further illegal dumping. The open dumped material is clearly railroad property.

VIOLATIONS:

ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT

21(a) No Person Shall Cause or Allow Open Dumping

21(e) No Person Shall Dispose, Treat, Store, or Abandon any Waste, or Transport any Waste into the State at/to Sites not Meeting Requirements of Act and Regulations

21(p) No Person Shall Cause or Allow the Open Dumping of Any Waste in a Manner Which Results in any of the Following Occurrences at the Dump Site:

(1) Litter

During the inspection, the open dumping of waste that resulted in litter in the form of railroad spikes and buckets was observed.



