<u>R18-9</u>	<u>In the Matter of: SDWA Update, USEPA Amendments (July 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017) (Public Water Supply)</u> – The Board adopted a final opinion and order in this “identical-in-substance” rulemaking amending the Board’s drinking water regulations.	5-0
<u>R18-15</u>	<u>In the Matter of: National Ambient Air Quality Standards, USEPA amendments (July 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017) (Air)</u> – The Board adopted a final opinion and order in this “identical-in-substance” rulemaking amending the Board’s air pollution regulations.	5-0
<u>R18-29</u>	<u>In the Matter of: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Subtitle M (Other)</u> – The Board adopted a proposal for public comment in this rulemaking to amend the Board’s potentially infectious medical waste rules.	5-0

<u>AC 18-9</u>	<u>County of LaSalle v. Jeffery Schuster</u> – The Board dismissed this administrative citation due to complainant’s failure to timely serve the administrative citation on the respondent.	5-0
<u>AC 18-10</u>	<u>IEPA v. DG Partners LLC; an Illinois limited liability company, Cissell-Mueller Construction Inc; a Missouri corporation, and Clifford M Koltzenburg and Chris S Koltzenburg, individually and d/b/a K & N Excavating</u> – The Board granted the Agency’s motion and dismissed the administration citation as to Cissell-Mueller Construction and Clifford M Koltzenburg and Chris S Koltzenburg, individually and d/b/a K & N Excavating. The also Board accepted respondent DG Partners’ petition for review involving a Hancock County facility.	5-0

<u>AC 18-11</u>	<u>IEPA v. Michael Crank individually and d/b/d as Crank Tree Service</u> – The Board accepted respondent’s petition for review involving a Saline County facility.	5-0
<u>AC 18-12</u>	<u>IEPA v. George Poe</u> – The Board found that respondent had violated Sections 21(p)(1) and (p)(3) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(3) (2016)). Because there were two violations of Section 21(p), the Board ordered respondent to pay a civil penalty of \$3,000.	5-0


<u>PCB 13-15</u>	<u>Sierra Club, Environmental Law and Policy Center, Prairie Rivers Network, and Citizens Against Ruining the Environment v. Midwest Generation (Enforcement, Citizens – Land)</u> – The Board denied the Environmental Groups’ motion to strike and Midwest Generation’s motion for sanctions.	4-0 Carter abstained
<u>PCB 18-64</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v Village of Marine, an Illinois municipal corporation (Water – Enforcement)</u> – In this water enforcement action concerning a Madison County facility, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2016)), accepted a stipulation and settlement agreement, and ordered respondent to pay a \$3,250 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.	3-0 Carter and Santos abstained
<u>PCB 18-79</u>	<u>Yongxin Enterprises, Inc. v. IEPA (UST Appeal)</u> – The Board accepted for hearing this underground storage tank appeal involving a site in Franklin County. The Board reserved ruling on petitioner’s motion for consolidation.	5-0
<u>PCB 18-80</u>	<u>Phillips 66 Company v. IEPA (UST Appeal)</u> – The Board granted this request for a 90-day extension of time to file an underground storage tank appeal on behalf of this Lake County facility.	5-0
