ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed July 8, 1974 is inadequate in that it does not reveal whether the three ponds and lake are used as a public water supply or connect to a water used as a public water supply. In addition, levels of rotenone and sulfoxide expected below the ponds and lake in Windfall Creek are not given nor is the effect of these levels upon aquatic life or in drinking water delineated.

Petitioner shall file an amended petition within 45 days providing the information requested above. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing of the amended petition. Failure to timely file the amended petition shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
