ORDER OF THE BOARD (BY SAMUEL T. LAWTON, JR.):

Petitioner seeks a variance from our sewer ban order entered in case entitled League of Women Voters v. North Shore Sanitary District, #70-7, 12, 13 and 14, 1 PCB 369 (March 31, 1971).

We are unable to tell from the petition what facilities of the District petitioner seeks to connect to. Greater details should be furnished on the unsuitability of the present septic system, together with a letter from the Lake County Health Department stating what health impact, if any, would result from a continuation of the present septic system. Such additional information shall be filed within fifteen days from the date hereof, together with a waiver of the provision requiring that the Board render its decision within 90 days of the filing of the original petition for variance.
