Hey, just got call from JCAR with another error. They will change the section symbol to "40 CFR" in 722.313(a)(3):

For the purposes of off-site management, an eligible academic entity must count all of its hazardous waste, regardless of whether the hazardous waste was counted toward generator category under subsection (a)(2), and if the eligible academic entity generates more than one kg per month of acute hazardous waste or more than 100 kg per month of non-acute hazardous waste (i.e., the VSQG limits, as defined in § 260.10), the hazardous waste is subject to all applicable hazardous waste regulations when it is transported off site; and
