ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Zeitlin):

The final Opinion and Order of the Board was entered on December 4, 1975. In a discussion of compliance efforts being undertaken by Petitioner Campbell, the Board there said, in part, "[t]his effort will involve taking each of the end presses out of operation " Opinion at 4.

On January 5, 1976, Campbell filed the instant Motion to Amend, asking that the above quoted language be changed to read, "[t]his effort will involve taking three of the end presses out of operation ... " (new language emphasized). The Motion is based on the fact that the Stipulation of the parties in this matter failed to show that three enumerated end presses did not constitute all of those used by Campbell at its Chicago facility.

The difficulty here apparently arose from a simple misunderstanding of the Stipulation by the Board. To correct the situation, we order that the Board's Opinion of December 4, 1975, be amended as requested and shown above.

Campbell also requested that certain additional language be added to the Opinion, claiming that while not contained in the Stipulation, the proposed language would reflect the true understanding of the parties. The additional changes requested by Campbell would, we find, constitute a modification of the Stipulation upon which our final Opinion and Order were based. There is no assent to such modification from the Respondent Environmental Protection Agency. Therefore, this portion of Campbell's Motion must be denied.
