HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On July 10, 2014, petitioner filed a motion in limine to bar evidence regarding the Agency's calculations used in it its determination that the costs for drum disposal exceeded the minimum requirements. Respondent did not respond. Petitioner asserts that the calculations do not appear in the administrative record despite the fact that the project manager describes the alleged calculations in an affidavit. By the time petitioner received a copy of the calculations, the document showed a date indicating that it had been modified after the determination was issued.

The Board has previously found instances where evidence is admissible in an UST appeal despite not being included in the administrative record. The purpose of the hearing is to explain the information relied on by the Agency for the denial. Thus, evidence may be admissible if it existed at the time of the Agency's determination, and would have been appropriate for the Agency to consider in its determination. *See e.g.* Freedom Oil Company v. IEPA, PCB 03-54 (Feb. 2 2006); Weeke Oil Company v. IEPA, PCB 10-1 (May 20, 2010).

In this appeal, the Board must determine whether drum disposal costs exceed the minimum requirement. To this end, the motion in limine is denied, and testimony regarding data and calculations used in respondent's determination shall be admissible at hearing. Any documents the Agency intends to introduce into evidence on this issue shall be provided to petitioner at least 24 hours before hearing.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
