HEARING OFFICER ORDER


On August 23, 2018, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The respondent stated that on August 16, 2018, another plumber visited the site and the parties are awaiting his inspection report. It was agreed to continue this matter to the date and time noted below.

To that end, complainant is to file her response to respondent's motion to dismiss for want of prosecution by October 31, 2018. The parties will revisit this due date at the next status conference.

Any deadlines for answering the request to admit or responding to the outstanding motions, including responding to respondent's motions for clarification and reconsideration filed August 24 and 25, 2016, are stayed.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on September 27, 2018, at 10:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.
