<u>R18-30</u>	<u>In the Matter of: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Subtitle O (Other)</u> – The Board adopted a proposal for public comment in this rulemaking to amend the Board’s Right-to-Know rules.	5-0
<u>R18-32</u>	<u>In the Matter of: Amendments to General Use Water Quality Standards for Chloride (Water)</u> – The Board accepted petitioner’s proposal to amend the Board’s water quality standards for hearing and granted petitioner’s motion to add an attachment to its proposal.	5-0

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ADMINISTRATIVE CITATIONS

<u>AC 18-13</u>	<u>IEPA v. Estate of Craig S. Walker and Walker & Sons Enterprises, LTD (Land)</u> – The Board granted the Agency’s motion to dismiss the administrative citation against the Walker Estate. The Board also found that respondent Walker & Sons had violated Sections 21(p)(1) and 55(k)(1) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) and 55(k)(1) (2016)). Because there were two violations of Section 21(p), the Board ordered Walker & Sons to pay a civil penalty of \$3,000.	5-0
<u>AC 18-14</u>	<u>County of Macon v. Tiffany Maple (Land)</u> – The Board granted complainant’s motion for voluntary dismissal.	5-0
<u>AC 18-15</u>	<u>County of Macon v. Edward Gunning (Land)</u> – The Board granted complainant’s motion for voluntary dismissal.	5-0

ADJUDICATORY CASES

<u>PCB 06-63</u>	<u>Dynegy Midwest Generation, LLC. v. IEPA (Air, CAAPP – Permit Appeal)</u> – The Board granted the parties’ joint motion, lifting the stay of the uncontested conditions of petitioner’s CAAPP permit and remanding that permit to respondent to incorporate the parties’ negotiated modifications.	5-0
<u>PCB 17-15</u>	<u>Illinois Power Generating Company v. IEPA (Water, NPDES, Permit Appeal)</u> – The Board took no action on this matter.	

<u>PCB 17-54</u>	<u>Illinois Railway, LLC., v. IEPA</u> (UST Appeal) – The Board granted petitioner’s motion for voluntary dismissal of this underground storage tank appeal.	5-0
<u>PCB 17-84</u>	<u>Illico Independent Oil Co v. IEPA</u> (UST Appeal) – The Board denied petitioner’s motion for summary judgment.	5-0
<u>PCB 18-72</u>	<u>Ted's State Line v. IEPA</u> (UST Appeal) – The Board dismissed this petition for review for failure to timely file a second amended petition complying with the Board’s May 24, 2018 order.	5-0
<u>PCB 18-75</u>	<u>Southern Ill. Power Cooperative v. IEPA</u> (Thermal Demonstration) – The Board accepted this petition for an alternative thermal effluent limit but reserved whether it will hold a hearing.	5-0
<u>PCB 18-81</u>	<u>Wabash Valley Service Company v. IEPA (Water – Tax Certification)</u> – The Board found and certified that specified facilities of Wayne Valley Service Company located in Edwards County are pollution control facilities for the purpose of preferential tax treatment under the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2016)).	5-0
<u>PCB 18-82</u>	<u>Illinois Power Generating Company v. IEPA</u> (Water, NPDES, Permit Appeal) – The Board accepted for hearing this NPDES permit appeal on behalf of this Montgomery County facility. The Board reserved ruling on petitioner’s motion to operate under the reissued permit, to allow the time for IEPA to file a response to run.	3-0 B.K. Carter and C.M. Santos abstained
