HEARING OFFICER ORDER


On March 24, 2014, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. Discussions centered on the case management schedule. Subsequent the conference call, the parties submitted an agreed case management schedule.

The agreed case management schedule is accepted to the extent as follows. Petitioner's witnesses and any opinions must be disclosed on or before March 28, 2014. Respondent's witnesses and any opinions must be disclosed on or before April 4, 2014. All depositions must be completed on or before April 18, 2014. Close of all discovery on or before April 18, 2014. All prehearing motions, including motions *in limine*, must be filed on or before April 22, 2014 by 12:00 p.m. All responses to the prehearing motions, including motions *in limine*, must be filed on or before April 23, 2014, by 12:00 p.m. The hearing will be held on April 29, 2014, and will continue as necessary. Based on an expedited transcript, petitioner's post-hearing brief due to be filed on or before May 9, 2014. Respondent's post-hearing brief due to be filed on or before May 16, 2014. Record closed on May 16, 2014. Public comment must be filed on or before May 6, 2014.

The mailbox rule does not apply to any of the above mentioned filings, and all electronic or approved telefax filings must be received by the Clerk's Office no later than 4:30 p.m. of the due date.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on April 3, 2014, at 11:00 a.m. The telephonic conference must be initiated by the petitioner, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


