HEARING OFFICER ORDER


On March 14, 2016, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. Discussions first centered on the new hearing dates. Conditioned on room availability, the parties agreed that the new hearing dates will be May 10, 11 and 12, 2016. The confirmed hearing dates, location and times will be noted in a notice of hearing.

Next, discussions were entertained regarding the parties respective and proposed discovery schedules. It was agreed that the parties are to propound written discovery on or before March 16, 2016. Responses to the written discovery are to be served on or before March 29, 2016. The disclosure statement of respondent's expert witness Keith Stoddard is to be served on or before March 31, 2016. All oral discovery is to be completed on or before April 21, 2016, however, the oral discovery schedule may be revisited at the next status conference. Parties are directed to serve all discovery and the disclosure statement with the Board on their due dates.

If complainant decides to call its own expert to counter respondent's expert, complainant may call its expert during its case-in-chief and in its rebuttal.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on April 5, 2016, at 11:00 a.m. The telephonic conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


