ORDER

On October 17, 1972 in PCB 72-243 we ordered that Jerry Frye close his landfill if he has not obtained a permit for its operation in 45 days. Jerry Frye now requests a 90 day extension of time to permit him to comply with necessary requirements for the issuance of a permit.
