On November 14, 2018, Radharani, Inc. (Radharani) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal (Mot.). The appeal concerns Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (Agency) December 19, 2017 determination regarding Radharani's leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at 201 West Main Street in DuQuoin, Perry County. The Agency partially denied Radharani's request for reimbursement from the UST Fund.

The motion states that the parties resolved their disagreements. Mot. at 1. The Agency did not object to granting the motion. The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal and closes the docket.
