AC 19-6	County of Macon v. Kori Rice (Land) — The Board found that respondent had violated Section 21(p)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2016)). Because there was one violation of Section 21(p), the Board ordered respondent to pay a civil penalty of \$1,500.	5-0
AC 19-8	IEPA v. Mary Auer (Land) – The Board found that respondent had violated Sections 21(p)(1) and 21(p)(7) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), 21(p)(7) (2016)). Because there were two violations of Section 21(p), the Board ordered respondent to pay a civil penalty of \$3,000.	5-0
