ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Marder)

Petition for Variance, filed November 6, 1974, by the North Shore Sanitary District, requesting relief from Water Pollution Control Regulations between October 1, 1975, through November 1, 1976, in order to complete its Gurnee Water Treatment Plant is inadequate in that the Petition contains no statements of the following:

- 1) No specific identification of the provisions of the Environmental Protection Act or Regulations from which variance is sought;
- 2) The quality of the influent and proposed effluent from the proposed plant;
- 3) An estimate of the quantity and type of contaminants that will be discharged from the plant;
- 4) A detailed discussion as to why the plant will not meet water quality and effluent standards;
- 5) A specific time schedule for completion of the plant;
- 6) A statement as to the environmental impact that the discharges will have on the Des Plaines River.

Petitioner shall file an Amended Petition in this matter within 35 days of the entry of this Order or suffer a dismissal as inadequate.
