John and Ray -

Blake, Marge and I met with Gary Schweers and Jerry Sullivan w/ LaFarge yesterday to discuss timing, manpower and scheduling of the 3S pond cleaning. Couple of things.

1. Gary is going to start working on the north end of the pond and removing some of that material. So is there any way the water can be directed towards the overflow of 3S and not over to 2S so we not have a hose going across the road that separates the two ponds? Gary will be bringing in trucks and equipment and we don't want him to repeatedly drive over the hose. He will also beginning handling/moving the material within the pond to start the dewatering process.
2. Is there anyway we can get a more powerful pump (John - I think you had rented one for a week). There is still a lot of water in there and LaFarge was thinking if we can get a larger pump to get the bulk of the water out, that would be quite helpful. The sooner the better. Did we rent a diesel fired pump a couple of months ago for 2S?
3. I will be talking with Glen w/ Beemsterboer to begin removal of all that material at the east part of the pond that has been pushed into the pond over the yrs. LaFarge cannot take this material and it is also covering up their ramp for the equipment to get in the pond. We'll stockpile that material at the back of the plant, I'll sample it and then hopefully it will meet the requirements for landfill.

The ambitious schedule has our contractor beginning work the week of August 24th. So it's imperative that we keep up on removing any standing water in the pond - either with a more power pump or a combination of some smaller pumps that can run continuously. I will be checking in with Gary at the pond probably every other day just checking on status and seeing what we can do to help him with the material handling.

Just let me know. I'm in this safety training all day today but wanted to give you guys an update on our discussions with LaFarge yesterday.
