Amy,

In the future will Powerton be required to clean the Secondary Ash Basin? If we do have to clean the basin periodically in the future, NRT expressed concern about the water infiltration we are currently experiencing. The concern is about possibility of the new liner floating up from the bottom and becoming damage during cleaning. NRT is suggesting that we consider installing a warning layer, if periodic clean is mandated. The cost of installing a warning layer is estimated between \$100,000 to \$150,000.
