ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Marder)

This matter coming to the Board on the Motion to Dismiss filed on October 7, 1974, on behalf of the Respondent, Environmental Protection Agency, the Board being fully apprised of the premises herein, finds as follows:

- 1) Petition for Variance was filed September 9, 1974, requesting a sewer ban variance in Olney, Illinois.
- 2) An Objection to the grant of such Variance was filed September 20, 1974.
- 3) Respondent, Environmental Protection Agency, has removed Olney from restricted status on September 26, 1974.

Therefore, Petition for Variance is moot, as Petitioner has the relief requested.
