


relieve this requirement upon the motion of the People and the alleged violator.⁹ The parties moved for this relief.¹⁰

Before it may grant the parties' motion, the Board must notify the public of the stipulation, proposed settlement, and request for relief.¹¹ The notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in LaSalle County.¹² If anyone files a written demand for a hearing within 21 days after receiving the notice, the Board will deny the parties' request for relief and hold a hearing.¹³ The Board directs the Clerk to give this notice.
