OPINION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle)

Petition filed September 9, 1974 is dismissed as inadequate. It is not clear whether petitioner desires to repair a septic system (for which no variance is needed) or to connect an existing building to a sewer.

The sewer to which connection is desired (if that is the case) is not named nor is the extent of its transport deficiencies detailed. Lastly, the alleged "health hazard" because of the faulty septic tank is not described nor verified by the Lake County Health Department.

The petition is dismissed as inadequate without prejudice.
