
At the April 14, 2014 status conference, the respondent stated that it will endeavor to file its expedited appeal of the April 8, 2014 Hearing Officer Order by the end of the day on April 14, 2014. The petitioner stated that it will endeavor to file its response by the end of the day on April 15, 2014.

The petitioner also stated that will endeavor to file a motion for leave to reply to respondent's response to petitioner's motion for protective order by April 15, 2014.

Finally, the respondent stated that it will endeavor to respond to petitioner's motion to supplement and petitioner's motion to file an amendment to its motion to supplement by April 15, 2014.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on April 17, 2014, at 3:30 p.m. The telephonic conference must be initiated by the petitioner, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


