**STEPAN COMPANY’S STATEMENT ADOPTING RESPONSES OF METROPOLITAN  
WATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT OF GREATER CHICAGO TO BOARD’S  
QUESTIONS TO PETITIONERS**


1) On July 24, 2019, the Illinois Pollution Control Board (“Board”) directed questions to the Joint Petitioners and the Agency regarding the Time-Limited Water Quality Standard (“TLWQS”) for Chloride and also requested that the parties provide comments and proposed revisions to the proposed TLWQS language for a Board Order in PCB 16-14 (Consolidated). The Board ordered that the questions and proposed revisions be filed by September 23, 2019.

2) On September 23, 2019, the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (“MWRD”) filed responses to the Board’s questions and also proposed comments and revisions to the proposed TLWQS language for a Board Order.



3) Stepan Company hereby states that it adopts and incorporates MWRD's responses to the Board's questions and also MWRD's proposed revisions to the proposed TLWQS language for a Board Order as part of its Petition for Chloride Time-Limited Water Quality Standard for Defined Chicago Area Water System / Des Plaines River Watershed, PCB 18-19.
