JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/31.1, (2010) and delegated to the County of Sangamon pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/4(r) (2010).

FACTS

1. Joe Chernis, Jr, ("Respondent") owner and registered agent for Midwest Demolition and Scrap, Inc. is an excavation, demolition contractor and scrape metal dealer operating this business within Sangamon County, Illinois.
2. That the Respondent is the owner of real property, with parcel number 14-12.0-176-019, with a legal description of PT E 1/2, NW 1/4, & PT SW 1/4, NW1/4,(former RR Row) 12-16-5, located in Springfield Township, Sangamon County, Illinois.
3. That said property is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("IEPA") Operating Permit and is designated with IEPA Land Pollution Control #1678225059

4. That Respondent has owned said property at all times pertinent hereto.

5. That on October 6, 2014, Darlene K. Powell of the Sangamon County Department of Public Health (“SCDPH”) inspected the above-described property. A copy of her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

6. That on November 24, 2014, Sangamon County Department of Public Health sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7009 3410 0001 2385 6526.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Darlene K. Powell during the course of her October 6, 2014 inspections of Respondent’s property, the County of Sangamon has determined that Respondent has violated the Act as follows:

1. That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010),

2. That Respondent caused or allowed the deposition of (i) general construction or demolition debris as defined in Section 3.78 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/3.78 (2010), or (ii) clean construction or demolition debris as defined in Section 3.78(a) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/3.78(a) (2008), a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2008), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of Three Thousand Hundred Dollars (\$3,000.00) for violation identified in (1) above as it is the second adjudication of this violation and a civil penalty of One Thousands Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) for the violation identified in (2) above, for a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than December 29, 2014, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the County of Sangamon and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$4,500.00) statutory civil penalty for both violation.


Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Sangamon County Department of Public Health and mailed to the attention of James D. Stone, Director of the Sangamon County Department of Public Health, 2833 South Grand Avenue East, Springfield, Illinois 62703. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The State's Attorney of Sangamon County may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty and/or hearing costs and/or interest, the State's Attorney of Sangamon County will seek to recover his costs of litigation.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION


Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a Petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Sangamon County State's Attorney, Attention: Sheri L. Carey, Sangamon County Complex, Rm 402, 200 South Ninth Street, Springfield, Illinois 62701. Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010),

provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against Respondent.

On **October 6, 2014** an inspection was conducted at the above referenced site by Darlene K. Powell of the Sangamon County Department of Public Health (SCDPH). The weather conditions at the time consisted of mostly sunny skies, moderate winds, and an air temperature of 70°F. The current inspection was prompted after SCDPH received a complaint alleging junk and debris were hauled to the site and open dumped.

The property consists of one parcel (9.51 acres) located at 2348 Sand Hill Road in Springfield, Illinois. Sangamon County Assessor's Office has Joseph J. Chernis Jr. listed as the property owner. Midwest Demolition & Scrap is operated at this location, and Illinois Secretary of State has Joseph J. Chernis Jr. listed as the registered agent for the business (see attached records and map).

Photos 001 – 020 were taken during the inspection and are representative of the conditions observed. The following apparent violations were observed (items correspond with the numbers in the attached inspection checklist):

5. **21(a) CAUSE OR ALLOW OPEN DUMPING** – Evidence of open dumping was observed during the inspection. Various items were observed on-site including, but not necessarily limited to, dimensional lumber, aluminum siding, waste tires, junk vehicles, semi-truck cabs, and metal (**Photos 001-020**).

6. **21(d)(1) and 21(d)(2) CONDUCT ANY WASTE-STORAGE, WASTE-TREATMENT, OR WASTE-DISPOSAL OPERATION WITHOUT A PERMIT OR IN VIOLATION OF ANY REGULATIONS OR STANDARDS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD** – Waste was disposed of without a permit granted by the Illinois EPA, and a waste disposal operation was conducted in violation of regulations adopted by the Illinois Pollution control Board. (See 21(a) above)

7. **21(e) DISPOSE, TREAT, STORE, OR ABANDON ANY WASTE, OR TRANSPORT ANY WASTE INTO THE STATE AT/TOSITES NOT MEETING REQUIREMENTS OF ACT AND REGULATIONS** – Waste was treated, stored, abandoned, and/or transported to a site not meeting requirements of the Act and Regulations. (See 21(a) above)

8. **21(p)(1) CAUSE OR ALLOW THE OPEN DUMPING OF ANY WASTE IN A MANNER WHICH RESULTS IN LITTER** – The open dumping of waste was caused or allowed in a manner which resulted in litter. (See 21(a) above)

8. **21(p)(7) CAUSE OR ALLOW THE OPEN DUMPING OF ANY WASTE IN A MANNER WHICH RESULTS IN DEPOSITION OF: (i) GENERAL CONSTRUCTION OR DEMOLITION DEBRIS AS DEFINED IN SECITON 3.160(a); OR (ii) CLEAN CONSTRUCTION OR DEMOLITION DEBRIS AS DEFINED IN SECITON 3.160(b)** – The open dumping of waste was caused or allowed in a manner which resulted in the deposition of general demolition debris. (See 21(a) above)

8. **55(a)(1) NO PERSON SHALL CAUSE OR ALLOW OPEN DUMPING OF ANY USED OR WASTE TIRE** - Evidence was observed to indicate the open dumping of waste tires was caused and/or allowed. (See 21(a) above)

11. **812.101(a) FAILURE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO DEVELOP AND OPERATE A LANDFILL** – A waste disposal site is operating without submittal of an application for a permit to the Illinois EPA to develop and operate a landfill. (See 21(a) above)

Additional Comments

Mr. Chernis was not on-site upon arrival of the inspector. Mr. Chernis was contacted via phone and met the inspector at the property approximately 15 minutes later to discuss the complaint and current conditions of the site. Mr. Chernis stated he has slowly been working to remove the solid waste that was initially observed during the March 2014 inspection. The piles of debris in question (**Photos 001-007**) were definitely smaller, and it was obvious some progress was made toward cleanup. However, items not previously observed, waste tires, junk vehicles, semi-truck cabs, and a pile of scrap metal, were now being stored on-site.

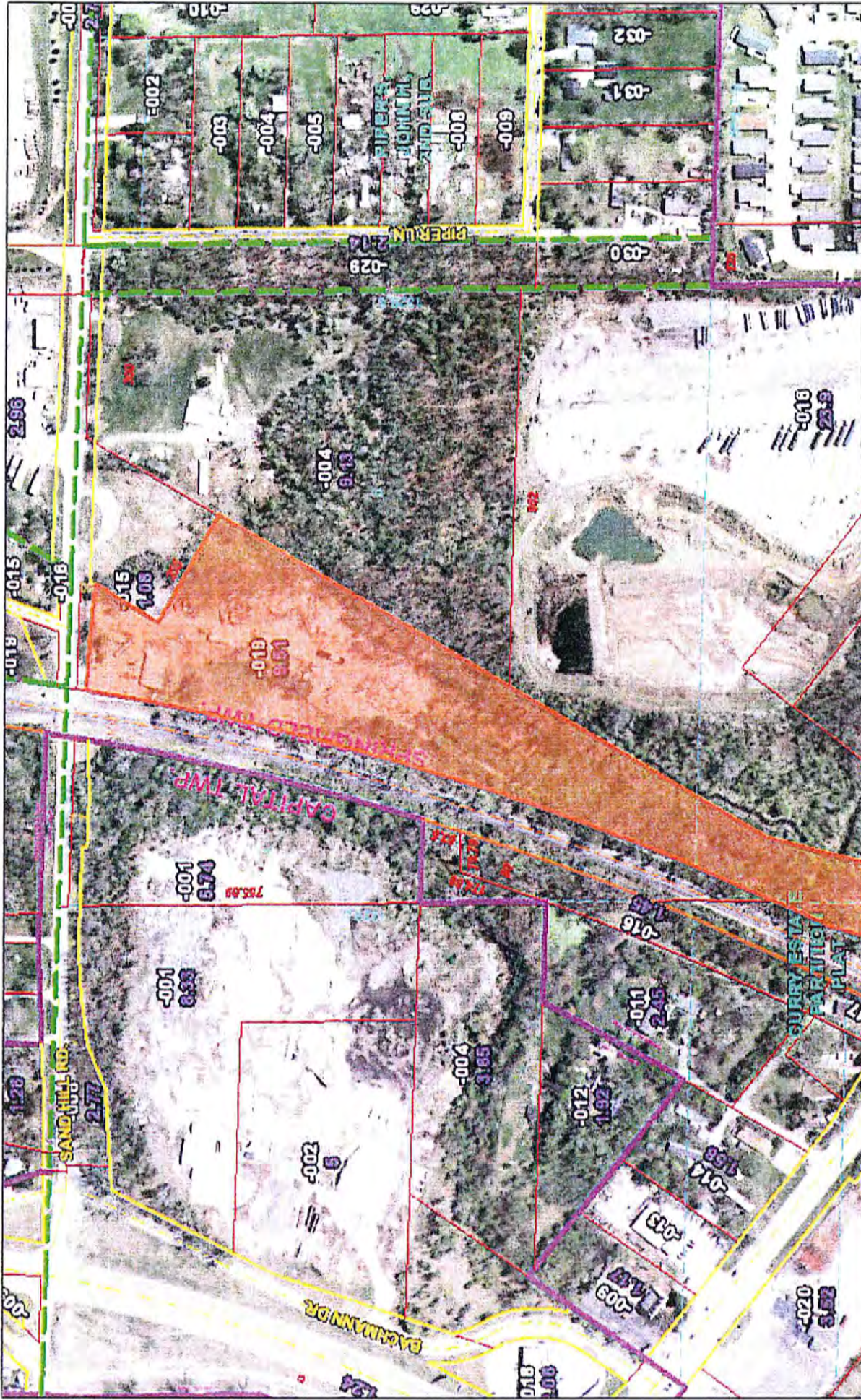
Mr. Chernis stated the waste tires were collected over time. Once a semi-trailer load of tires has been accumulated the trailer is taken to Shaner's for proper disposal. The junk vehicles were temporarily being stored for somebody who has issues with flooding at a different property. Once the other property dries out the vehicles will be returned to the owner. Mr. Chernis noted the vehicles would be removed from his property within the next week. When asked where the property with flooding issues was located and who the owner was Mr. Chernis stated he preferred to not provide a name or location. Mr. Chernis noted the metal and semi-truck cabs were hauled on-site to sort and eventually scrap for cash. Mr. Chernis is aware his property is not currently zoned for such activity. Mr. Chernis has tried to get the zoning changed for his property but has been unsuccessful up to this point.

Mr. Chernis was informed another report would be generated as a result of the current inspection. However, enforcement actions would be determined by SCDPH Administration. It was not possible to tell Mr. Chernis what steps would be taken by SCDPH at that moment. Mr. Chernis stated he understood and would wait to hear from the Department.

Earlier this year, on March 6, 2014 an inspection was conducted by representatives of SCDPH after the Springfield Fire Department called in a complaint alleging garbage and demolition debris were open burned on-site. Open dumping and burning violations were cited as a result, and an Administrative Citation was filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

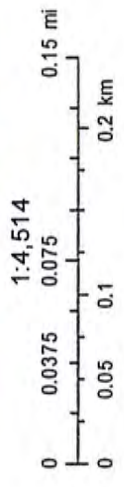

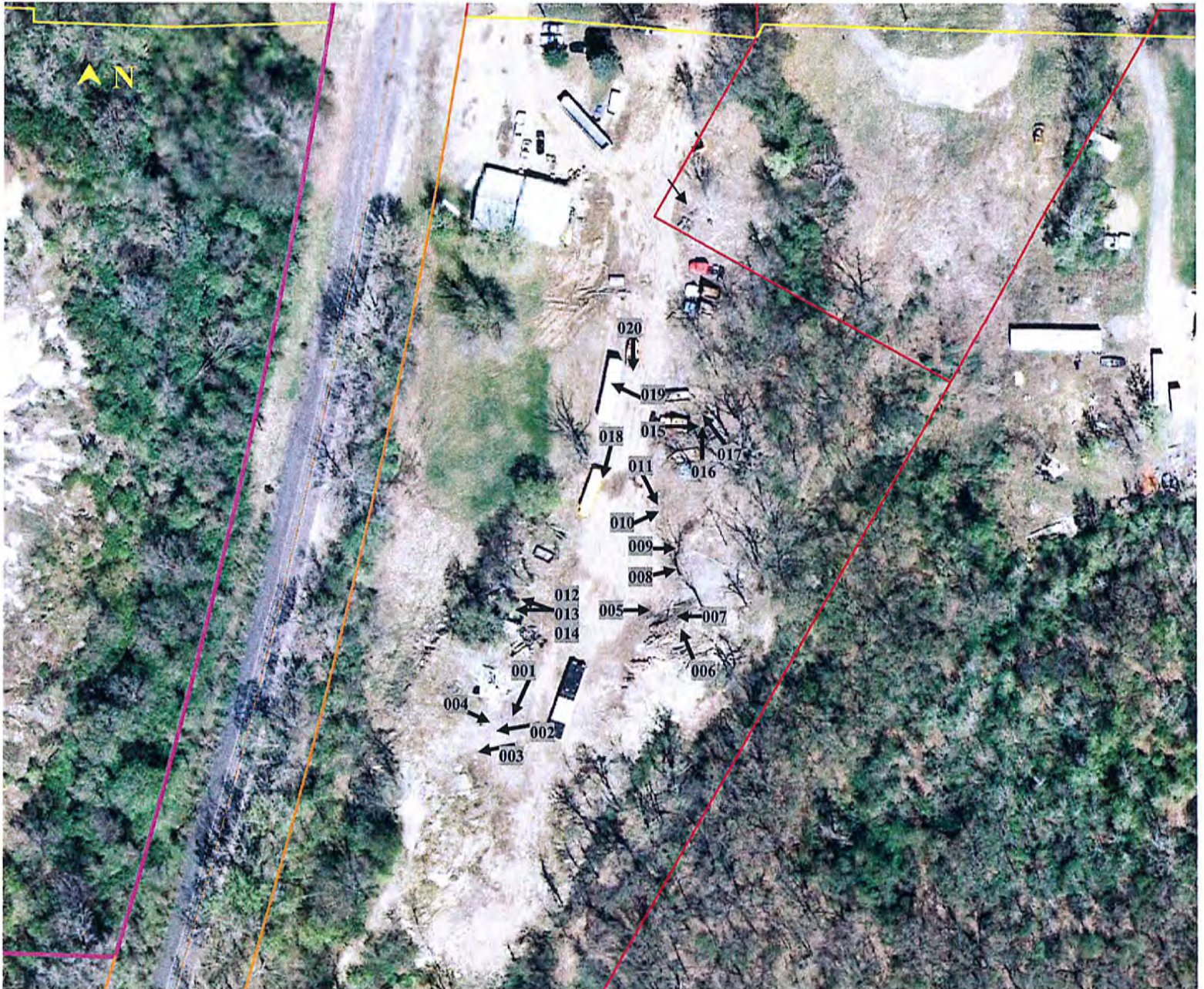

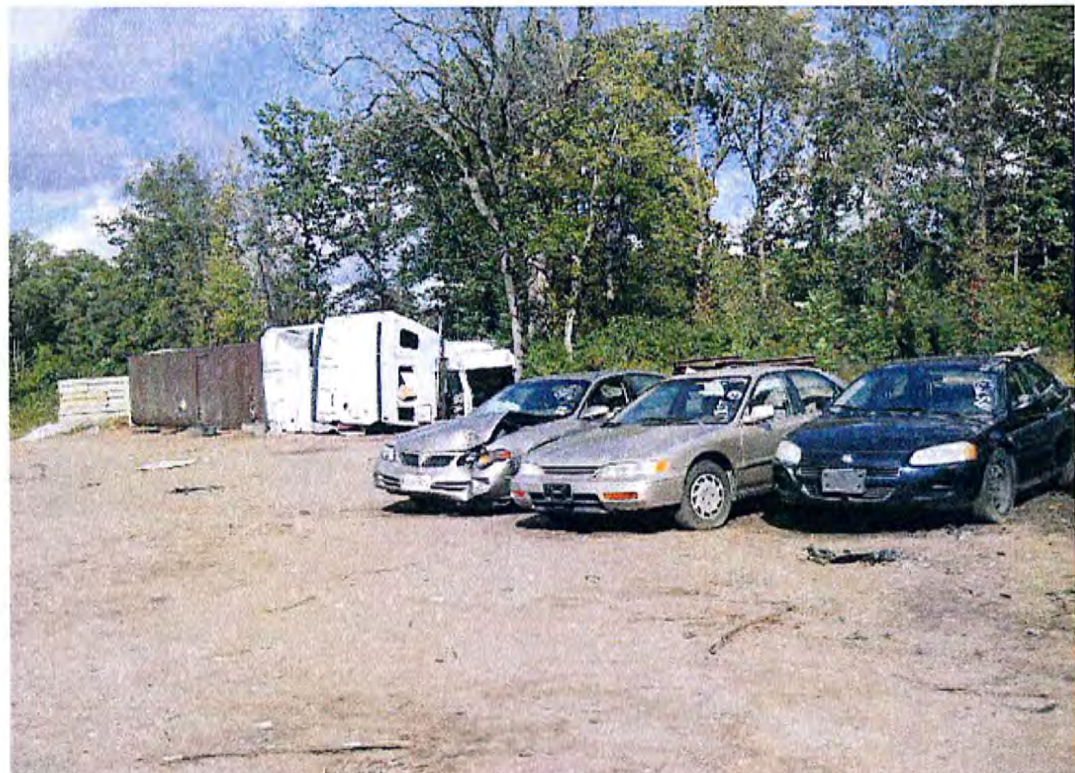
