



**RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

1. On September 27, 2018, the Illinois EPA received a request from Ron Rooth on behalf of Rooth Farms (log number TC-140368, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.
2. The facility's address is:

953 130th Avenue
Joy, IL 61260

The proposed water pollution control facility in this request is located in the SE ¼ of Section 36, T15N, R5W of the 4th P.M. in Mercer County, at the above street address and consist of the following facilities:

Livestock waste handling facilities consisting of one (1) concrete manure pit (approximately 51 ft. x 391 ft. x 8 ft.), the concrete slatted portion of the floor over the manure pit that capture and contain waste generated in the barn above, and ten (10) pumpout pits (approximately 5 ft. x 6 ft. x 8 ft. each) to allow manure removal from the manure pit, PVC perimeter drainage pipes (approximately 885 ft. x 6 in.) located around the footing of manure pit to prevent flotation of the pit, and one (1) plastic inspection/sampling port (approximately 8 ft. x 12 in.) on the perimeter drainage pipe.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport, and/or store livestock waste prior to cropland application, and is further described in Exhibit A.

3. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2018), and Section 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define

"pollution control facilities" as:


any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.

4. In order to receive preferential tax treatment as pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5 (2018), pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35 ILCS 200/11-20 (2014) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).
5. Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation on the application with the Board, 35 Ill Adm. Code 125.204(a).
6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facility, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and is eligible for tax certification from the Board.

7. Additionally, there was a discrepancy between the application and the "Narrative Description of Pollution Control Facility with Diagram." The application indicates only one building while the Narrative Description indicates that there are two. This was clarified in subsequent communication, and the application is correct in that only one building is on this property.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.

The Bureau of Water received a request on September 27, 2018 from Ron Rooth for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204. We offer the following recommendation.

The livestock waste handling facilities consisting of one (1) concrete manure pit (approximately 51 ft. x 391 ft. x 8 ft.), the concrete slatted portion of the floor over the manure pit that capture and contain waste generated in the barn above, ten (10) pumpout pits (approximately 5 ft. x 6 ft. x 8 ft. each) to allow manure removal from the manure pit, PVC perimeter drainage pipes (approximately 885 ft. x 6 in.) located around the footing of manure pit to prevent flotation of the pit, and one (1) plastic inspection/sampling port (approximately 8 ft. x 12 in.) on the perimeter drainage pipe. The facility collects, transports and stores livestock waste prior to cropland application.

The facility is further described in the enclosed applications and supporting documents.

Based on the information included in this submittal, it is our engineering judgment that the above proposed facilities may be considered "Pollution Control Facilities" under 35 IAC 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in this section, and therefore eligible for tax certification from the Illinois Pollution Control Board. The Bureau of Water therefore recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification for these facilities.

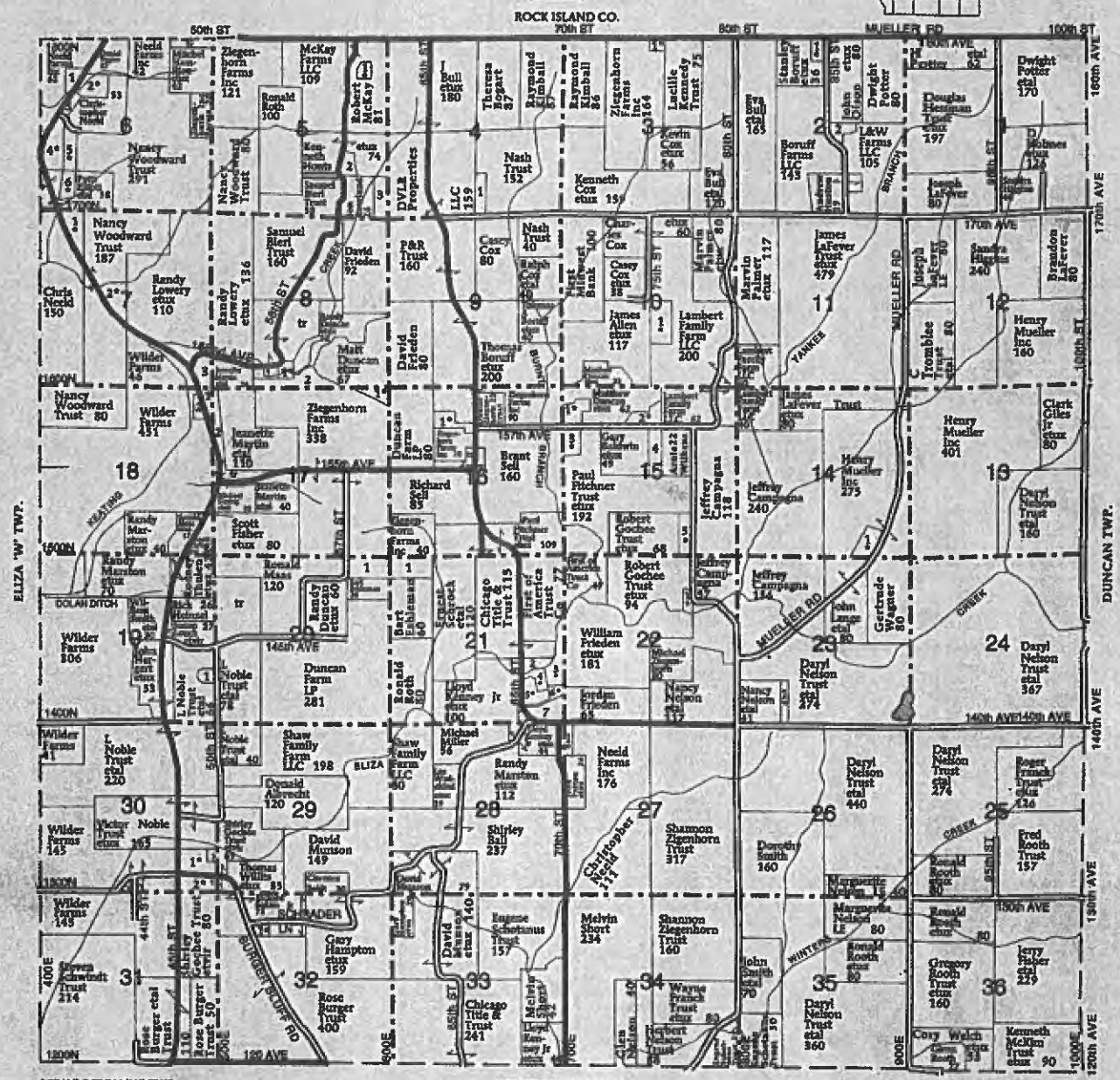

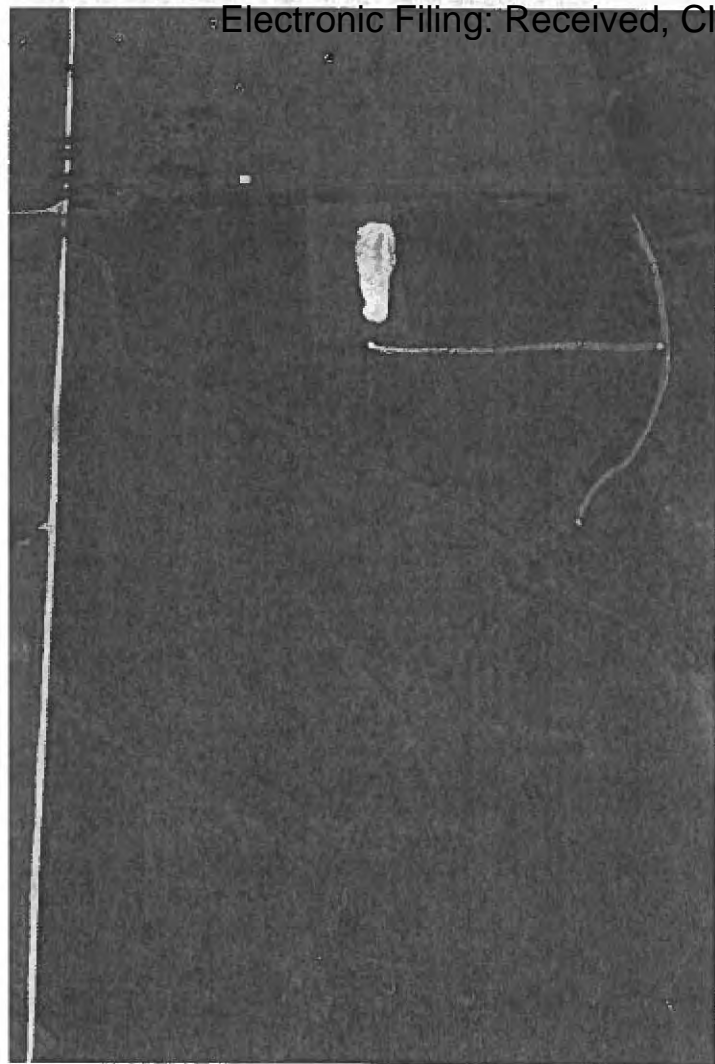

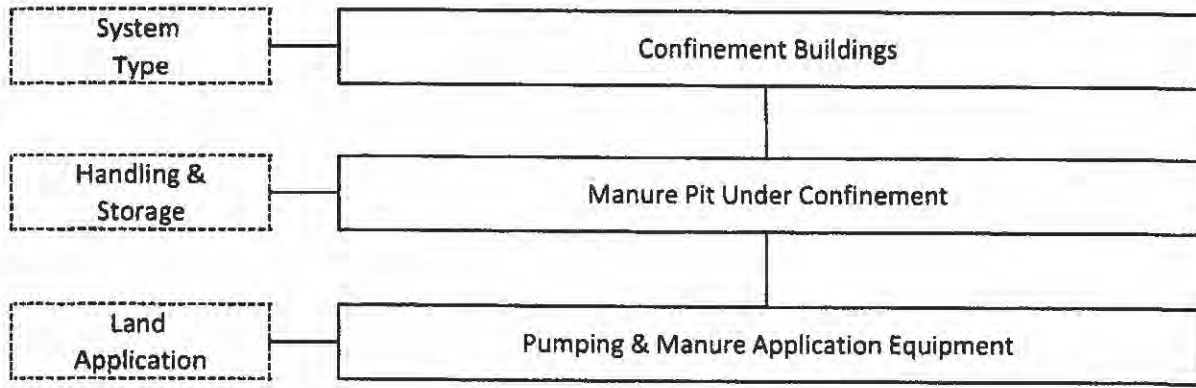

Narrative Description of Pollution Control Facility with Diagram

Two wean to finish hog buildings measuring (51' x 391' x 8' deep pit) each. Buildings consist of concrete foundations and concrete slatted floors over 100% of the (51' x 391' x 8' deep pits). Finished grade around buildings prevents freshwater from running into pits. Manure storage is adequate to contain 14 months of manure production per building which will safely protect the well and nearby crop from contamination. An inspection port (8' deep with a 12" diameter plastic tile access) provides monitoring access to the perimeter tile around the buildings and soil near the pit area. Manure from the pits will be pumped annually and applied through sub surface injection at an appropriate agronomic rate to nearby cropland.

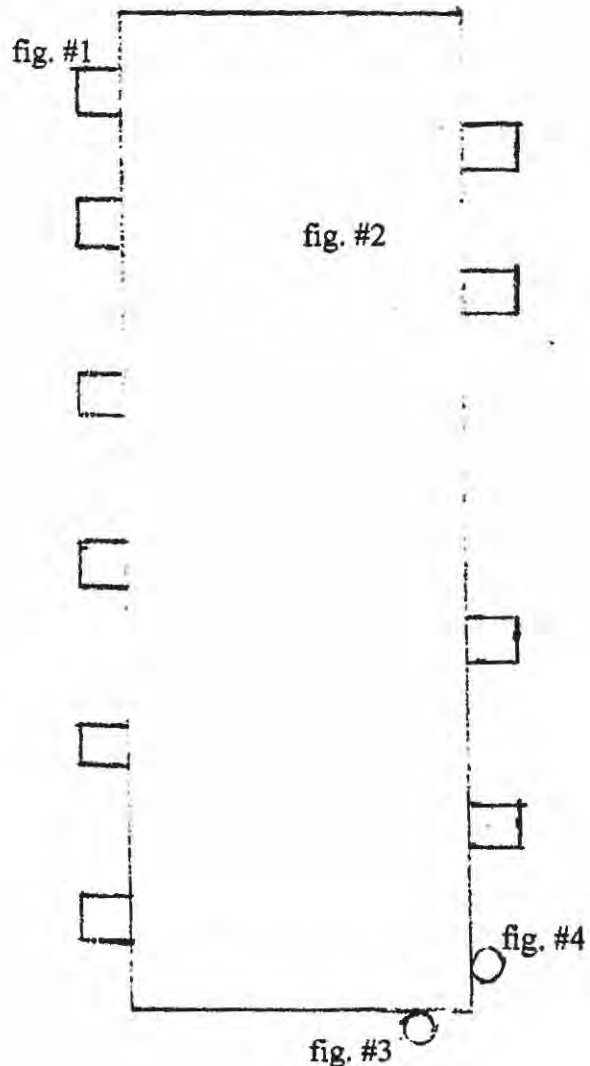
Building (51' x 391' x 8' deep pit) diagram per building as follows:

-Grass vegetation surrounds both buildings and field road.

-10 concrete pump outs per building measuring 5'x6'x8' deep protrude on both sides of the buildings foundation. Concrete pump outs indicate where the manure will be removed annually and then applied at an appropriate agronomic rate to neighboring crop land. See fig. #1

- Slatted concrete flooring over liquid manure pit. fig.#2

-Inspection port for perimeter tile surrounding both buildings. Fig. #3 indicates the inspection port on the North Building. Fig. #4 indicates the inspection port on the South building.



2. The 700 feet drainage tile is not sufficient to surround a building with dimensions 51 by 391 feet. Please confirm the length of drainage tile or the dimensions of the building.
