The Attorney General has brought a case against the Hendrickson USA, L.L.C. (f/k/a Hendrickson Bumper & Trim) for violation of State pollution control rules. On May 27, 2014, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing.
