HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On February 19, 2014, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. Discussion centered on the proposed discovery schedule submitted on February 19, 2014. Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) attorney, Phillip McQuillan, requested that the discovery cutoff be extended to September 2015, and not January 5, 2015, as proposed in the discovery schedule. Mr. McQuillan cited a number of reasons to protract the schedule, including the departure of IDOT's other attorney, Lance Jones.

To that end, issuance of written discovery requests was extended seventeen days, to March 17, 2014. The remaining proposed discovery schedule was accepted to the extent as follows. The parties must complete fact discovery on or before August 1, 2014. Disclosure of complainant's expert reports on or before September 2, 2014. Respondent's to depose complainant's experts on or before October 1, 2014. Disclosure of respondent's expert reports on or before October 29, 2014. Complainant to depose respondent's experts on or before November 26, 2014. Complainant's rebuttal expert reports are to be served on or before December 23, 2014. Expert discovery cutoff is January 5, 2015.

Further, any amendments to the pleadings and to join other parties must be on or before May 1, 2014. Summary judgments or other dispositive motions must be filed on or before February 28, 2015.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on April 1, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.
