INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

The petitions for the subject matters are inadequate in that they do not adequately relate the environmental consequences of the variances if granted. No data are given of ambient hydrocarbon concentrations in the area or of the frequency of occurrence, if any, of photochemical amog and oxidant formation.

A hearing will be held. The subject matters may be consolidated at the discretion of the Hearing Officer. Petitioner shall amend each petition within 35 days to supply the needed information.
