**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**


On December 5, 2019, Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), filed a motion for extension of time to respond to Johns Manville (JM) motion for interlocutory appeal. IDOT's response was due on December 6, 2019. IDOT requested an additional two business days, or December 10, 2019, to respond. JM has objected to a two-day extension but did not object to a one-day extension. JM's concern was that allowing IDOT additional days to respond would possibly prolong the Board's decision on its motion for interlocutory appeal and would therefore not be decided upon prior to the hearing tentatively scheduled for commencing on February 3, 2020.

Over JM's objection, IDOT's motion for extension of time was granted and its response is now due December 10, 2019.

Another issue that surfaced is IDOT's expert witness, Steven Goblelman, has suffered an injury to his ankle. IDOT states that due to his injury, he will not be able to attend the hearing commencing on February 3, 2020. IDOT intends to file a motion to cancel the hearing and reschedule. IDOT stated that it will file the motion to cancel "before the holidays".

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on January 6, 2020, at 11:30 a.m. The parties are advised that an earlier conference call may be needed to address the expected motion to cancel hearing. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance.


