The Environmental Protection Agency has filed a Motion for Leave to File a Second Amended Complaint. The pleadings should be settled in sufficient time so that all parties might have an opportunity to prepare for trial. An amendment coming at this late date would not give the Respondent sufficient time to prepare a defense.
