Opinion was entered in this case on May 31, 1973. On June 19, 1973 the Agency filed a Motion to reconsider based mainly upon the Board's interpretation of "process weight" as used in Rule 201.

The Johnson and Johnson Company filed an answer on June 26 requesting denial of the Motion to Reconsider.

IT IS THE ORDER OF THE BOARD that,

1. The Motion to Reconsider is denied and,
2. The interpretation of the term "process weight" as it appears in the May 31, 1973 opinion shall be construed as applying to the special circumstances of the Johnson and Johnson case only pending an opinion to follow which will discuss the "process weight" definition issue at greater length.
