ORDER OF THE BOARD (BY SAMUEL T. LAWTON, JR.):

Petition for variance has been filed in the above-captioned case. The matter will be set for hearing.

However, it is not clear from the petition exactly what provisions of the relevant statute or regulations petitioner seeks to have varied. Petitioner is directed to file a statement of amplification with both the Board and the Agency, within 15 days from the date hereof, specifying precisely what sections of the relevant statute or regulations petitioner seeks to have varied by this petition. The 90-day statutory period in which a variance must be granted shall commence upon receipt of the foregoing submissions.

The Agency will file its recommendation within 21 days from the receipt of said submissions.
