

PUBLIC NOTICE

On July 21, 2015, Flint Hills Resources Joliet, LLC ("FHR"), located at 23425 Amoco Road, Channahon, IL 60410 (Will County), filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") a Petition for Variance, under Title IX of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"). Variances may be granted pursuant to Section 35 of the Act (415 ILCS 5/35) and 35 Ill. Admin. Code Part 104.

FHR requests a variance from the deadline for complying with the new water quality chloride standard of 35 Ill. Admin. Code § 302.407 (g)(3). This request is necessary due to the impacts on the Lower Des Plaines River from upstream discharges, which are documented

In the Board's June 18, 2015, Final Notice in the R08-9(D) Rule-making, FHR is requesting to extend the effective date of the new water quality standard because it will not be able to determine an appropriate means of compliance until the upstream impacts have been resolved.

Any person may request a hearing by filing with the Board a written objection to the grant of the variance, together with a written request for hearing, within twenty-one (21) days after the publication of this Notice.

A copy of FHR's variance petition is available from the Clerk of the Board and the Clerk's Office On-line System ("COOL"). The Clerk of the Board may be contacted at the following address and phone number: Illinois Pollution Control Board, James R. Thompson Center, 100 W. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") is preparing a recommendation regarding this variance petition and is seeking the views of persons who may be adversely affected by the variance. The Illinois EPA is to file its recommendation within forty-five (45) days after the filing of the petition, which is by September 4, 2015. All comments and inquiries should be addressed to Sara Terranova, Assistant Counsel, Division of Legal Counsel, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, Post Office Box 18276, Springfield, IL 62794-9276. Ms. Terranova may be contacted at (217) 558-3098 or sara.terranova@illinois.gov. All comments and inquiries should be submitted within 21 days after the publication of this Notice.

A hearing may be held after the filing of the Illinois EPA recommendation. The record of this proceeding remains open for written comment for forty-five (45) days after filing of the Illinois EPA recommendation. Comments must be mailed to the Board at the above address for the Clerk of the Board.

The record in this variance proceeding is available at the Board's office for inspection, except those portions that are protected from disclosure under 35 Ill. Admin. Code Part 130. Procedures are available whereby disclosure may be sought by the public.
